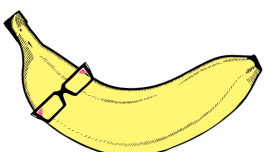
The Core Idea and Facts of the

Penguin Expedition is a life changing Experience.

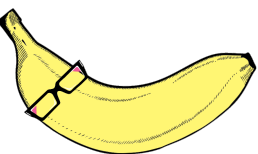

What is this Penguin Expedition?

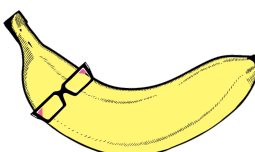
- You can see and feel the spirit of Team Academy on its best when the new penguins (first years) are here.

- Number of participants is limited to 10 people to keep it intense and cozy.



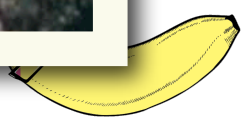
